NSW WATER TOWERS & ART SILO TOUR

DAY 1: (LD) HOME TO NARRANDERA: Monday 02 May 2022

We depart today at 6.30am for our tour through Country NSW looking at many of the colorful painted Silos and water towers. Our first stop this morning is in *Murrumburrah* to look at the Silo that was completed in February. From here we head to Wagga Wagga to look at the *Willans Hill Water Tank*, then this afternoon we see the *Milbrulong* and *Lockhart Water Towers* and the Tim Fischer statue in *Boree Creek* before arriving in *Narrandera* for our overnight stay.

DAY 2: (BLD) NARRANDERA TO DUBBO: Tuesday 03 May 2022

This morning we hit the road and head through Barellan to view the *"Big Tennis Racquet"* erected to commemorate tennis player Evonne Goolagong-Cawley. From here we travel to *Weethalle* to view the painted Silo, followed by our lunch stop in Ungarie. Here we also see *Ungarie's Big Football*, a heartfelt tribute to AFL legends, the Daniher brothers. This afternoon's journey takes us through Condoblin to see the interesting Utes in the paddock before arriving into *Dubbo* with time to relax before dinner.

DAY 3: (BLD) DUBBO TO NARRABRI: Wednesday 04 May 2022

From Dubbo we make our way to the small town of *Gulargambone* to see the water tower showing a Kingfisher bird diving for fish. Whilst in town there are several murals we can see, then we are off to *Coonamble* and *Walgett* where we stop for lunch. The *Walgett Water Tower* depicts Jimmy Little, a celebrated and beloved Australian Aboriginal musician, actor and advocate whose career spanned six decades. This afternoon we arrive in Narrabri and have afternoon tea and a look through the Visitor Information Centre, then we meet a local guide for a town tour and hear all about the local cotton industry. Dinner tonight is at the *Outback Shack Bar and Grill* located within the Narrabri RSL Club. The 'Outback Shack' is full of historical memorabilia, mainly sourced from local properties and features a stunning mural of the main street of Narrabri from yesteryear.

DAY 4: (BLD) NARRABRI TO GULGONG: Thursday 05 May 2022

Leaving Narrabri after breakfast we now head to the small town of Barraba and stop for a look at the Silo art mural that was painted by Fintan Magee. This mural depicts a local water diviner searching for groundwater, using a y-shaped twig or rod or two L-shaped ones. From here we head to Gunnedah and stop at the Gunnedah Water Tower Museum and look at the Mural. The mural facing west features a group of soldiers from 7RAR waiting to be picked up by the iconic Huey helicopters, while the mural facing north includes soldiers paying their respects beside the Long Tan Cross. Whilst in Gunnedah we take a look at the Gunnedah Art Silo that has extracts from the Dorothea Mackellar poem "My Country". This afternoon we stop in Dunedoo for a look at the Silos that feature Winx, a retired champion Australian thoroughbred racehorse and her famous rider Hugh Bowman, who was also born in Dunedoo.

DAY 5: (LB) HOMEWARD BOUND: Friday 06 May 2022

This morning we depart Gulgong and head south to Portland and the Silos known as *"The Foundations"*. The old Portland Cement Works were painted by Guido van Helten and depict five male and one female past Portland Cement workers. We have lunch in Lithgow and this afternoon start making our way back to the coach via the Blue Mountains.
