



Day 1: Thursday 18th March 2021 (Lunch / Dinner) Nowra to Narrandera

Depart Stuarts Coaches depot – 339 Greenwell Point Road Worrigeen at 8.00am travel via Sutton Forrest onto the Hume Highway, Morning at **Gunning** and Lunch will be at **Coolac Pub**
Arriving at our Accommodation at Narrandera Club Motor Inn for the next 4 nights

Day 2: Friday 19th March 2021 (Breakfast/ Lunch)

Our First stop is the **Narrandera Memorial Gardens**, then off to the Visitor Centre for the opportunity to purchase tickets for those of us who wish to see a show that is held over the weekend; otherwise we can enjoy the vast amount of free entertainment on offer. Tonight the festival opens with Australian Music and yarn spinning, dinner is at passengers own expense and there will be many different options available from the festival or various eateries in town. The Festival is start across the road in the Narrandera Park.

Day 3: Saturday 20th March 2021 (Breakfast)

Today we have the full day at the festival. The atmosphere will be fantastic with street markets, busking competitions, art displays and the Narrandera Folk Festival Parade to enjoy. Lunch and dinner today is your own expense.
